SELF-GUIDED VISIT

- Full access to the whole farm

CURRICULUM LED TOPICS



Animals & Us

This session is based around the farm animals including sheep, cows, pigs & donkeys. It may include a visit to the Goat Walkthrough where children can get really close to the animals and have the opportunity to feed some of them!

Our dedicated keeper will include a brief overview of different breeds & species. their various needs, and how we care for them here at Hogshaw Farm.

Adaptations & Habitats

This session looks at animal habitats and how different species have adapted to survive in the wild. Our keeper will provide the children with information about the animals daily routines, feeding needs and how we try to create natural habitats here at Hogshaw Farm.

There will be the opportunity to get up close to some of our birds. invertebrates & reptiles.

Predator & Prey

This session focuses on what it means
to be a predator or prey and the
difference between the two. Our keeper
will talk about how animals interact with
other species and how we can encourage
natural behaviours here at Hogshaw
Farm.

Most of this session is based in the Wildlife Zone with visits to see our birds of prey. Scottish Wildcats & Lynx.

Please note that the animals needs vary on a daily basis so we can't guarantee that a particular species will be available.

We sometimes need to make changes to your session on the day.

TIMINGS & PRICES

AVAILABILITY

Every week day, during term time

Arrival from 10:00am

Departure by 2:30pm

Note: We are closed to the general public on Mondays & Tuesdays, so our catering outlets are also closed on these days.

GROUP SIZES

- Minimum of 20 & maximum of 60 people per visit.
- For Special Educational Needs (SEN) groups, the adult to child ratio must be 1:1 and these adults will be admitted free of charge.

GROUP PRICES

Self-led Group £7.50 per person

Self-led + Keeper session £9.00 per person

Under 2's FREE

- For educational groups, one adult is free for every four paying children.
- £50 non-refundable deposit and completed booking is required to secure your group visit date.

EXTRA VISITORS

Adults £9.00 per person

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PAYMENT TERMS

- A £50 non-refundable deposit is required within one week of booking to secure your chosen date.
- The minimum price for an educational / group visit is £50.
- On the day of your visit, a balance invoice will be issued based on your actual numbers. This invoice will be due for payment immediately.

CHANGES & CANCELLATIONS

- Cancellations with <u>less than one month's notice</u> are non-refundable, but for an administration fee of £30 your visit can be rescheduled to another available date.
- Cancellations with less than two weeks' notice are non-refundable and non-transferable.

BEHAVIOUR & SUPERVISION

- Visitors should be calm around our animals and listen carefully to instructions (animals can bite and kick!).
- · Children are not to be left unsupervised at any time during the visit.
- We have lots of hand-washing facilities on site and encourage visitors to wash or sanitise hands thoroughly after any contact with animals.
- We expect all visitors to treat our staff with respect at all times.
- We reserve the right to ask a group to leave the farm if behaviour is deemed inappropriate or puts the welfare of our animals at risk.

LEAVING

• It is your responsibility to check that you have collected all of your belongings before leaving the farm. We do try to reunite lost property with it's owner, but this isn't always possible.
